
Private Research, Shared Research, Publication, and the Boundary Transitions



This domain involves the core research team as they undertake the research, usually within a single institution. Access is often tightly controlled as hypotheses and analyses are developed. This domain involves researchers outside the core team as they collaborate with colleagues, often across institutions. Access is more open, but not everything is shared. This domain involves the public sphere (publication in the sense of making public). Access usually open to all.
