

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# -Accidental, sorry, "Non-intentional" first steps


- April 2002

  - First Steering Committee meeting



  - Faculty Manager





### Developing the strategy

- Collaborative and iterative effort
- Large programme of interviews with stakeholders (DVC down), focussing initially on their information painpoints
- Drawing on existing statements of need in IT Strategic Plan and other planning documents



### Strategy document

- Comprehensive: 100+ pages, 35K words
- Outline
  - Definitions, scope, theoretical models
  - Information Principles
  - Analysis
  - Further work
  - Governance
  - Turning Strategy into Action



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### We all need approval

- Strategy has been approved by Vice Chancellor's Group
- Implementing the Strategy is one of the five university priorities for 2006
- Strategy has been publicly released for comment as exposure draft
- Prioritised recommendations fed into university planning cycles
- Information needs will routinely be evaluated as part of new initiatives

### Successful intervention

- Need to make a difference by operating as a process of change management across four areas:
  - Strategy
    - > Where do we want to get to?
  - People
    - > How can we skill our staff to come along with us?
  - Process
    - > What can we improve as a result of this change?
  - Tools
    - > Which tools can we give people to make them more effective and efficient?



### Implementing the Strategy

- Focussing for 2006 on activities grouped into four themes
  - Working with content efficiently and effectively
  - Using the web to deliver information and services
  - Providing high quality management information
  - Supporting collaborative activity
- · Plus necessary underpinning infrastructure

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# Using the web to deliver information and services

- · Develop and implement web strategy
- Progressively web-enable corporate applications
- Recommendations of portal review
- Targeted portal services for staff roles
- Monash intranets for students and staff

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# Working with content efficiently and effectively

- Better Info Mgt support for eResearch
- Review of Novell/Intranet/Extranet envts
- Electronic Document & Records Mgt System
- Move to server-based storage for critical shared docs
- Move to backed up storage for in-process docs
- Embed information ownership in PDs
- Enhance ability to search across information islands

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# Providing high quality management information

- · Continue work on data quality
- Implement application integration solution
- Enhance TARDIS research management business intelligence system
- TARDIS-like offering for L&T?
- Integrated reporting/BI offering
- Responding to 2006 AUQA audit

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### Supporting collaborative activity

- Implement recommendations of 2005 Workgroup Collaboration Services review
- Design templated collaboration workspaces for targeted user communities
- · Develop email management strategy
- Respond to special needs of eResearch sector
